



Rexel is taking part in the 'Yale Climate Change Dialogue' working group

Rexel supports this initiative which is being led by the Yale Center for Environmental Law & Policy and aims at promoting the emergence of tangible solutions with global appeal to meet climate challenges through a multi-stakeholder and multi-disciplinary approach.

The work of the 'Yale Climate Change Dialogue' focuses on three main ideas:

- Broadening climate change engagement by creating structures within and alongside the 2015 Paris Agreement to promote and formalize the role of mayors, governors/premiers, CEOs and other civil society leaders.
- Designing metrics and reporting structures that will encourage contributions from these sub-national jurisdictions and other non-national actors and strengthen accountability mechanisms.
- Advancing a shift in climate change investments strategy, particularly in clean energy, toward an emphasis on the use of limited public resources to leverage private capital.

On May 26 & 27, Rexel hosted the Yale Climate Change Dialogue at its headquarters in Paris. The purpose of the Paris meeting was to refine a “broader engagement” strategy for the UN Climate Change Conference.
